No Uniforms

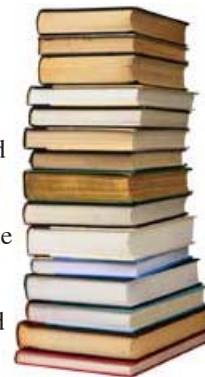
